The Danish National Symphony Orchestra will perform Nielsen's Symphony No. 4, "The Inextinguishable" and Sibelius's 'Valse triste', and Anne-Sophie Mutter will perform Sibelius's 'Violin Concerto' with the orchestra.

Nielsen's "Inextinguishable"
Symphony is an intense
orchestral journey from
despair to victory, featuring a
dramatic duel between two
sets of timpani in the final
section before the
triumphant finale. Also a
study in intense energy,
Sibelius's Violin Concerto is
famous for the opening hairraising cadenza that's a
virtuosic high-wire act for the
soloist.
