Installations to Brooklyn Bridge Park



A number of interactive art works, by internationally renowned Danish artist Jeppe Hein, will be display in Brooklyn Bridge Park from May 17.

Engaging visitors through pieces that are both accessible and surprising, the show includes three distinct bodies of work: Appearing Rooms, a series of "rooms" formed when water shoot up from the work's gridded base forming "walls" that appear and disappear throughout the day; A large new Mirror Labyrinth, featuring equidistantly spaced vertical elements at varying heights made from mirror-polished stainless steel that multiply the surrounding landscape through myriad reflections; and 16 new Modified Social Benches that suggest the idea of traditional park benches but with unconventional angled, twisted, and bent forms.

You can explore Jeppe Hein's interactive sculptures at the Brooklyn Bridge Park from May 17, 2015 – to April 17, 2016.
